


## 2. PLANNING YOUR LAYOUT


Mock up with paper, planning gives a perfect finish. Mock up on the wall the layout with pieces of paper using a tape measure for a neat even look.

# **1. SELECTING YOUR ITEMS**

Almost anything can have visual impact when framed and hung. Collate and collect by mixing the gallery frames and fill with photos, fabric, postcards and found objects.




### **4. FINAL CHECKS**

Take a step back and ensure you are getting the desired effect. By constantly checking from a distance you will ensure the frames look good as the selection grows.

## **3. HANGING YOUR FRAMES**


Anchor your favourite image in the centre and work your way out. Get help from a friend and keep holding up the frames to check, measuring as you go.







# **GALLERY FRAMES** Styles of hanging




### FORMAL LAYOUT


6 frames of the same size that can be shown over a sideboard or console. With our poster frames you are given a choice of mounts so you can ring the changes.

## CENTRED

Set the theme with the central image and then the satellite frames can have objects and images that tell a story.

**INFORMAL FAMILY** Perfect mix of an informal family portrait, kids artwork and related photos.

## **TELL A STORY**

Large poster frames. Create a story line with three large images from the same occasion.

**IRREGULAR MIX** An informal gallery wall for all your memories. Mix frame colours, sizes and contents for an eclectic feel.

## **ON THE SHELF**

Curate a mix of frames on a picture shelf with a mix of images objects and photo's.
