- Check everything is there (the 'parts page' is a handy checklist). Check everything is the
- Pop all the loose fittings and fixtures into the packaging provided or tie them up in a plastic bag
- Wrap all the big components back up in the original protective packaging.
- Close up the box and seal it securely (don't be afraid to use plenty of tape).

DON'T



- Leave anything assembled - all components should be dismantled and separately packed.
- Put loose fixtures and fittings straight into the box.
- Throw it back in the box carelessly – as it may get damaged.

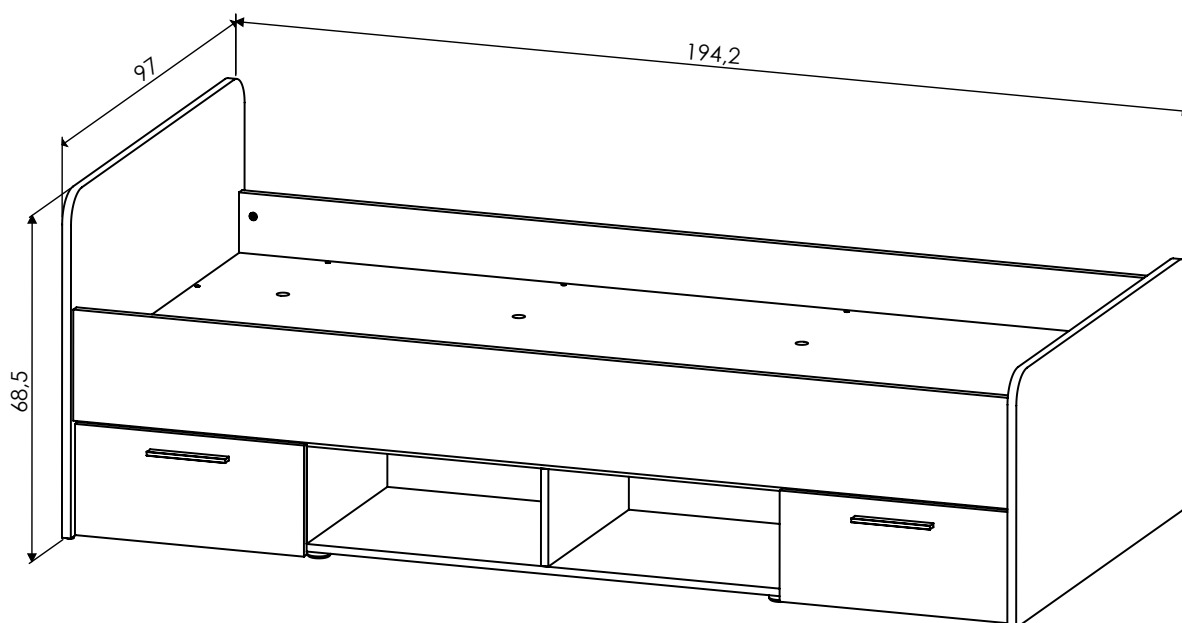

#### CHILDREN'S FURNITURE

This bed conforms to BS8509:2008 + A1:2011

**WARNING:** Do not place this bed near heat sources, windows and other furniture

**WARNING:** Do not use this bed if any part is broken, torn or missing

**WARNING:** Assembly to be carried out by a competent adult only. During assembly children should be kept away from the product due to possible risk of injury

**WARNING:** Once assembled this bed is not designed to be disassembled and reassembled.

Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, blind cords, curtain pulls or other strings or cords and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 300mm between the wall and the side of the bed

**WARNING:** Not suitable for children under 4 years.

This bed is suitable for children in the age range 4-12 years.

#### Do's

We suggest you spend a short time reading through this leaflet before you start.

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools and plenty of space.

Due to the size of the product we recommend that it is assembled in the room intended for use

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on a clean surface to protect them from damage,

We recommend that the packaging is used to protect the surfaces during assembly

Carefully check that you have all the parts before beginning assembly.

Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.

This size of the mattress to be used with the bed is 900mm x 1900mm.

Ensure the product is fully assembled as illustrated and all fixings fully tightened before use.

Check fixings regularly to ensure they remain tight.

When moving your assembled bed. It is best to lift the bed and never to drag it.

Wipe occasionally with a soft cloth dampened with water. Then buff with a dry clean soft cloth.

If any parts are missing please contact Next to obtain replacements. Under no circumstances should missing parts or hardware be substituted unless obtained from Next

#### Don'ts

Do not drag or pull your furniture.

Do not use silicone based furniture polish. Silicone in furniture polishes can break down the finish.

Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture.

Absorption can cause wood to warp or finishes to de-laminate.

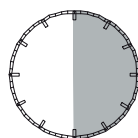
Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly on to the wood surface. Please make sure you use a placement or coaster.

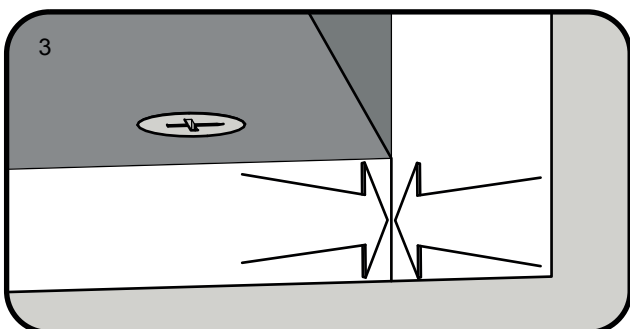
## TITUS TIGHTENING INSTRUCTIONS



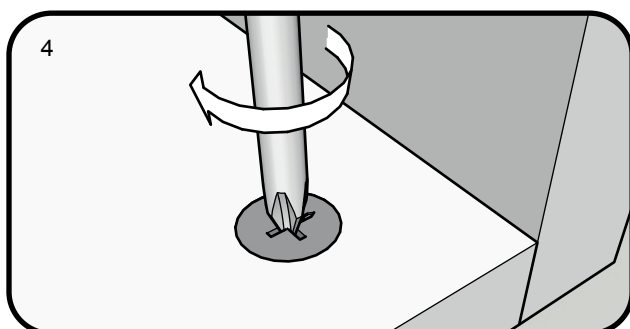
Line up the arrow on the CAM with the PIN.



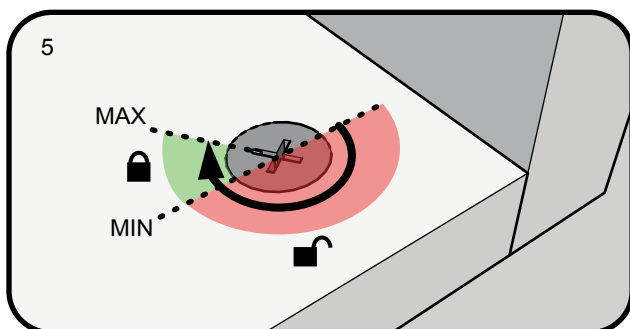
Push the pins into the holes in the panel to be joined.



Make sure there is no gap between the panels.



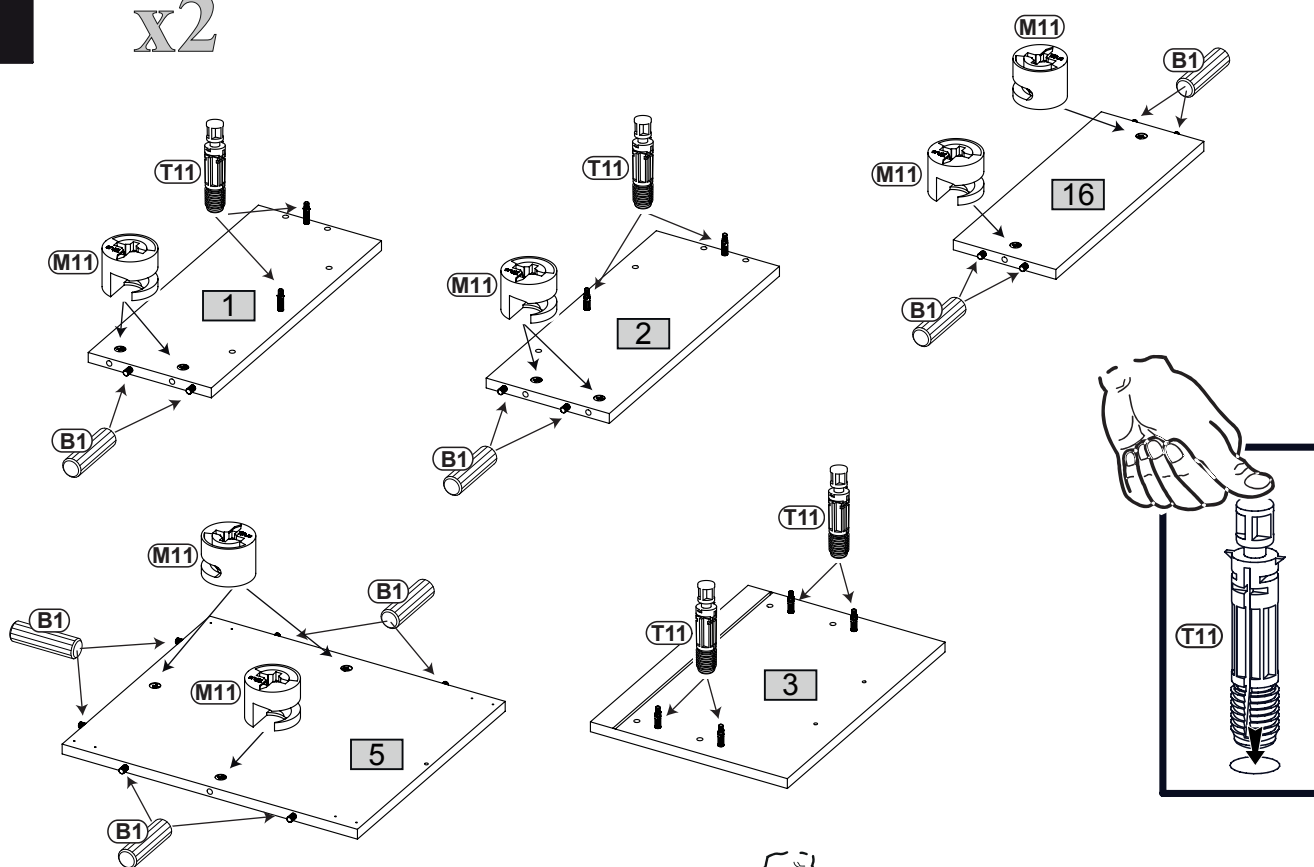
Use a cross-point screwdriver (PH2 or PZ2 is ideal) to tighten the cams and lock the panels together.



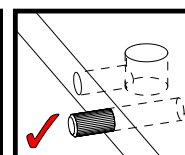
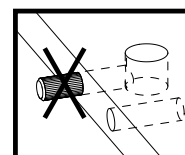
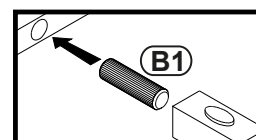
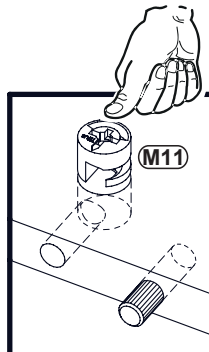
The panels are locked when each cam is turned to between 1/2 and 2/3 of a full turn (Maximum rotation)
