Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary Please do not sit or stand on your table.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on top of the carton box or on a clean floor to protect it from damage.

This product should only be used on firm, level ground. Make sure the legs remain in contact with the ground.

Use glass cleaner or soapy water for cleaning, do not use anything abrasive as this may damage the surface of the product.

Do's

We suggest you retain these instructions for future reference We suggest you spend a short time reading through this leaflet before you start.

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools and plenty of space.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on a clean surface to protect it from damage, We recommend that the packaging is used to protect the surfaces during assembly. Carefully check that you have all the parts before beginning assembly.

Please retain the assembly tools. You will need them in the future to re-tighten the bolts, or if you want to dismantle the furniture for storage.

Please make sure that the product is clean and dry before putting it into storage.

We recommended the use of furniture covers to protect your furniture when not in use. During severe weather conditions, please move your furniture inside.

To clean your items, please use mild detergent in warm water. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly. Do not use abrasive cleaners, strong detergents, bleach, acid or solvents on the frame parts.

To prevent damage occurring due to high temperatures, please ensure coasters or placemats are used and avoid placing glass directly onto the surface.

To prevent damage from sunlight by removing glass or other clear items when not in use. Wipe any water droplets from the table surface.

When cleaning polywood, use a damp cloth or chamois, with soap or washing-up liquid if necessary.

Don'ts

Do not stand on your chair.

Do not sit on the arms of your chair. (Note: arm chair only) When moving furniture never drag the pieces across the floor, as this will cause damage to the joints.

Please do not leave your product outside when not in use.

During bad weather and winter months the product should be dismantled and stored in a cool dry place.

Do not place extremely hot or cold items directly on top of the surface.

Do not use silicone based furniture polish.

Do not use the surface as a cutting board.

When cleaning polywood, never use washing powder or other products containing scouring agents, as these may scratch the surface



- 2. Do not place extremely hot or cold items directly on top of the surface.
- 3. Do not sit or stand on the table surface.
- 4. Do not use the surface as a cutting board.
- 5. Cover the furniture with a weatherproof cover when not in use.
