Never leave a burning candle unattended. Burn candle out of reach of children and pets. Always leave at least 15cm between burning candles. Do not burn candle on or near anything that can catch fire. Remove all packaging before lighting. Do not burn if vessel is cracked or damaged. Always burn candle in a well ventilated draught free area. Always place candles in an upright position. Always place on a heat resistant surface, away from flammable materials. It is extremely important that no part of the candle is close to another heat source i.e. a radiator, open fire, direct sunlight or another candle; as this may cause uneven burning and a weakening of that particular part of the candle. Always allow ample headroom for the heat from the flame. Never allow the flame to touch the side of the vessel. Candle container will become hot. Never move a burning candle. Keep wicks evenly spaced and trimmed to 5mm at all times to avoid smoking. For best results burn your candle for at least 2 hours bur no more than 4 hours at a time. This will allow your candle to create a full wax pool so it burns evenly all the way down. Keep the wax pool clear of matches and other debris to avoid flaring. Stop use when 10mm of wax remains. Extinguish the candle if it flickers, smokes or the flame gets too high. Do not blow out the candle or use liguid to extinguish. Always use a candle snuffer to extinguish your candle.
